- The smallest: E bat poos are tiny, measuring only 1cm or so long!
- The crumbliest: E bat poos crumble if you squish them, this is one way to
- tell them apart from mouse poos
- The freshest: Hard to tell, but possibly A
- The shiniest: B hedgehog poos often contain insect remains including the iridescent wing cases of beetles beautiful!
- **The sneakiest:** F owl pellets come out the owl's mouth. Its regurgitated food rather than poo.
 - The biggest: Hard to tell but possibly C or G badger and fox poo are often
- a similar size but badger poos are more often found together in piles (latrines)
- The sloppiest: Hard to tell, but possibly G or C. Badgers eat all sorts
 - including worms and berries, which you can often tell from their poo
- The smelliest: This depends on your own opinion! Fox + badger poo are
 - both very pungent and otter poo smells fishy
