What is a camera trap?

Its a camera which is triggered to take a photo when it detects movement. This means you can set up up and leave it as you don't have to press any buttons when you want to take a photo. If an animal walks in front of the sensor it will take.



What is it used for?

Camera traps are often used to spot more elusive wildlife. Especially animals which would be easily scared away by humans, or that you don't come across very often. You can leave camera traps alone for a while and come back to look at the photos later.
